MARNINGS

The Safe Load BW Insert Gooseneck ball is for personal, non-commercial use only.

Responsibility falls on the driver to properly adjust the towing equipment and to adjust his or her driving habits to account for the trailer requirements, the towing conditions, and the road conditions. The driver alone is responsible for their own safety and the safety of any passengers in the vehicle.

Thoroughly read, understand, and follow all safety warnings, setup, use and maintenance instructions of your tow vehicle, trailer and towing/hitching equipment prior to installing your hitch and before towing your trailer.

Even if a dealer installed your gooseneck hitch, verify that the ball is properly inserted and secured prior to your trip.

ALWAYS verify adequate turning clearance between the truck cab/bed corners and trailers. Ensure there is a minimum of 6" of clearance between the bottom of the trailer overhang and the top of the truck bed sides.

ALWAYS inspect all Safe Load BW Gooseneck Ball components to ensure everything is installed properly and secure prior to each trip. Do NOT tow your trailer until all components have been checked.

ALWAYS use a tow ball size that matches your trailer's coupler size and double check to make sure the tow ball and trailer coupler are properly and securely joined prior to towing.

ALWAYS ensure trailer chains are securely attached to safety attachments.

ALWAYS verify that safety chain length has just enough slack to allow a full turning radius without interference but not too much slack.

ALWAYS load the contents of a trailer correctly and properly. Follow tow vehicle and trailer manufacturer's recommendations for quantity and placement of cargo.

NEVER tow more than one trailer at a time as this may cause loss of control.

NEVER tow until your hitch is properly installed.

NEVER exceed the weight rating specified for the tow vehicle, trailer, hitch, tow ball, or any other towing equipment.

NEVER cut, weld, grind, bend, or modify any of the hitch components in any way. meets or exceeds the Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) requirements for your specific trailer.

X INSTALLATION

STEP 1: Unlatch the B&W Turnover Gooseneck Hitch ball pin to the unlocked position to allow you to insert the Gooseneck Ball.

STEP 2: Insert your Safe Load BW Insert Gooseneck Ball into the receiver tube with the gauge facing the desired direction. We recommend facing the gauge towards the rear so it can be easily viewed while the trailer tongue is being lowered. Lock the ball pin by latching the B&W Turnover Gooseneck Hitch handle. Always double check to make sure that the lock engages and the ball is secured.

REMOVAL & STORAGE

To remove the Safe Load BW Insert Gooseneck Ball, unlatch the B&W Turnover Gooseneck Hitch ball pin to the unlocked position. Lift the tow ball out of the receiver tube and return the ball pin the the locked position.

When not in use, store your Safe Load BW Gooseneck Ball in the provided case where it will be protected from weather conditions and insert the rubber cap into its place over the receiver to prevent dirt and debris from getting inside.

MAINTENANCE

Always keep your Safe Load BW Gooseneck Ball clean and the corners lightly greased to ensure easy insertion/removal.

To ensure easy and proper function, remove any dirt or debris from your B&W Turnover Gooseneck Hitch receiver tube prior to inserting the Safe Load BW Gooseneck Ball.
